

FACTSHEET:

SUGGESTED WORDING FOR YOUR WILL

A pecuniary or specific legacy to The Coroners' Courts Support Service (CCSS):

"I give the sum of (£XX in words and figures) free from all taxes and duties or (specific named item) to Coroner's Courts Support Service registered charity number 1105899 of for its general charitable purposes and I direct that the receipt of the Treasurer or other duly authorised officer shall be a good discharge of the same."

A residuary legacy to CCSS:

"I give (XX)% of my residuary estate to Coroner's Courts Support Service registered charity number 1105899 for its general charitable purposes and I direct that the receipt of the Treasurer or other duly authorised officer shall be a good discharge of the same."

And for completeness ...

You may want to think about including the following clause to safeguard your gift for the future and to prevent any confusion as it is becoming more common for charities to change their names and/or merge with likeminded organizations to better continue their work.

"If at my death any charity named as a beneficiary in this my Will or any Codicil hereto has changed its name or amalgamated with or transferred its assets to another charity then my Executors shall give effect to any gift made to such charity as if it had been made (in the first instance) to the charity in its changed name or (in the second instance) to the charity which results from such amalgamation or to which such transfer of assets has been made."
